## COMMON OR LOCAL NAMES OF COMMERCIAL FISH AND SHELLFISH OF ALASKA

Many species of Alaskan fishes are known by different names in different localities. In some instances, the same fish may be known by several names in the same locality. This confusion of common names often creates problems in the orderly marketing of Alaskan fishes both in Alaska and in the continental United States.

Leading biologists and taxonomists do not always agree on the proper common names for an animal or plant. For positive identification they rely on the scientific name, which is always in Latin. Reference to the list of Alaskan fishes below will make it very obvious that the layman—the fisherman, the wholesaler, the retailer, or the housewife—would be even more confused than now if suddenly the Latin rather than the common or English names were used in the markets.

One of the long-range major objectives of the Fish and Wildlife Service is to standardize, as much as possible, the many local names now in use for American fishes. The purpose of this leaflet is to compile the names given each species of Alaskan fish so that reference to the list will provide producers and marketers with a common denominator of understanding regarding each species under consideration.

The list of suggested common names has been checked against various published papers on the fisheries of the Pacific Coast. In addition, it has been reviewed by personnel of the Service and the Alaska Department of Fisheries.
