

The Smoke-Curing of Fish and the Application of a Controlled Method to the Process. by Clarence L. Anderson and Robert K. Pederson, is Technological Report No. 1, recently issued by the Technology Division, Department of Fisheries, State of Washington. A brief explanation of the principles involved in smoke-curing and a description of a modern controlled smokehouse as well as some smoke-curing processes are given in this 20-page report.

In addition to listing the advantages of the controlled smokehouse in the smokecuring of fish, it describes smoking procedures for kippered salmon, cold-smoked salmon, hot-smoked smelt, and smoke-curing prior to canning of anchovies, salmon, smelt, oysters, razor clams, and rock clams.
