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COVER: Deep-sea (offshore) otter trawler operating in the North Atlantic groundfish and ocean perch fisheries. At Massachusetts ports in 1953 a total of 232 of these otter trawlers (70 large, 162 medium) landed 5,231 trips with a total catch of 277 million pounds, mostly haddock, ocean perch, and cod. The Service's experimental vessel Delaware is a large trawler converted to freeze the catch at sea (see page 1 of this issue).

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
