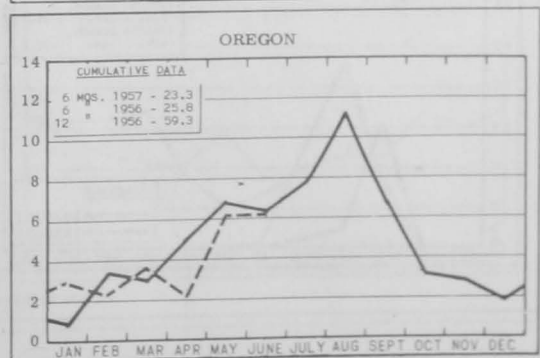
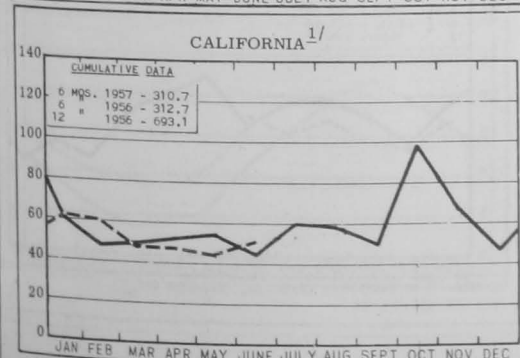
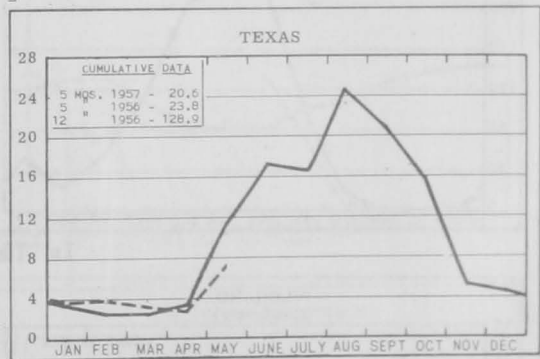
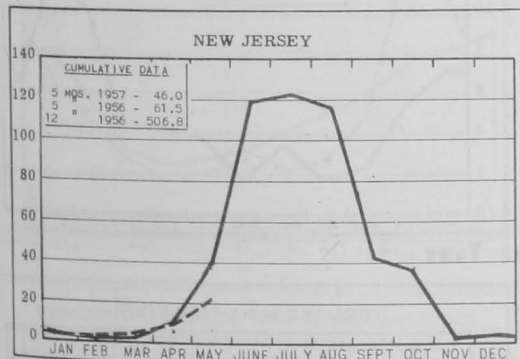
## CHART I - FISHERY LANDINGS for SELECTED STATES In Millions of Pounds

# CHART 3 - COLD-STORAGE HOLDINGS and FREEZINGS of FISHERY PRODUCTS \*

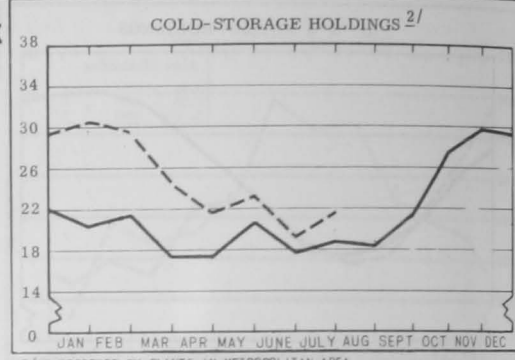
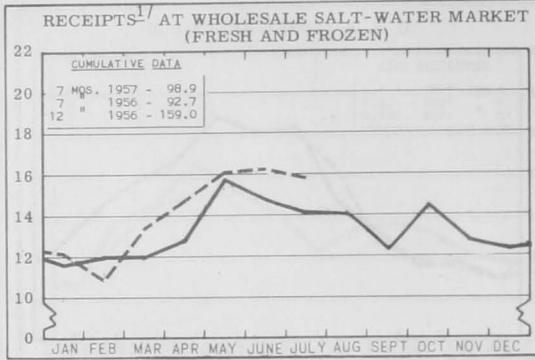

# CHART 5 - FISH MEAL and OIL PRODUCTION - U.S. and ALASKA

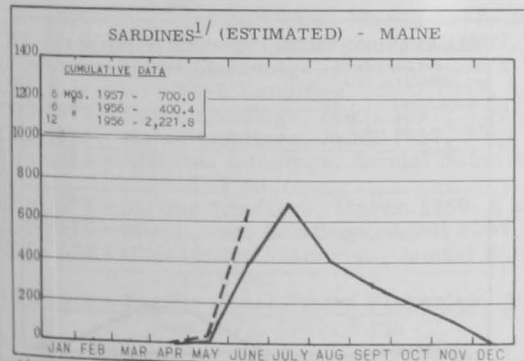
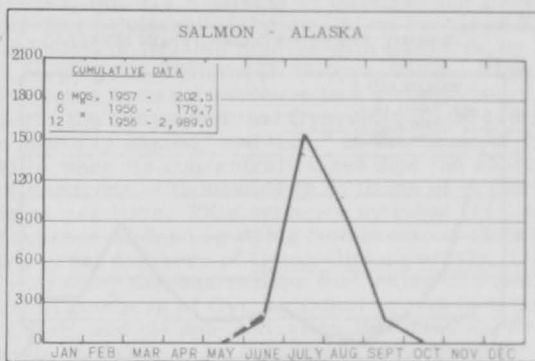
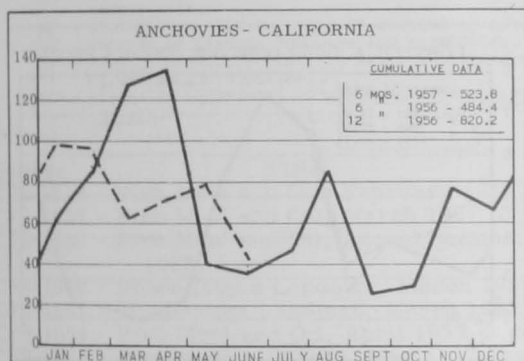


# CHART 6 - CANNED PACKS of SELECTED FISHERY PRODUCTS

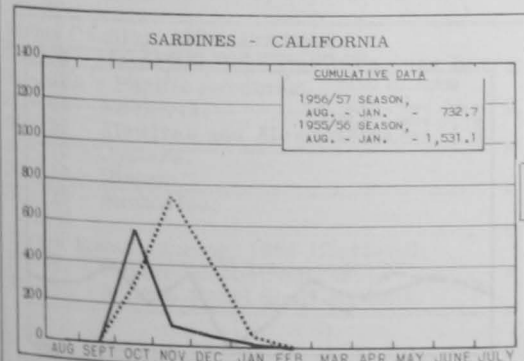

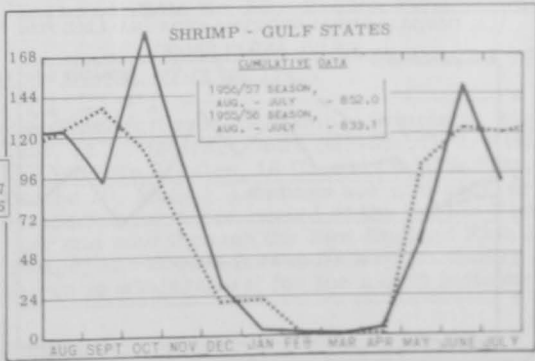
