

COVER: A new U. S. Public Health Service (PHS) exhibit, "Safe Shellfish," for showing at health and fishery conferences. Describes the state-PHS Cooperative Program for the Certification of Interstate Shellfish Shippers. Display uses color transparency photographs of shellfish harvesting and inspection scenes. Exhibit points out that operating controls, including sanitary surveys of growing areas, policing of polluted or toxic areas, and the inspection of shellfish plants are exercised by the states and that the PHS function is one of developing uniform standards, continuing appraisal of state programs, and publication of the semimonthly lists of state-approved shellfish shippers.
