## CONTENTS

COVER: Soviet trawler Krym near United States North Pacific coastal waters off Washington State. In mid-July 1963, the 125-foot Soviet trawler was operating 50 to 75 miles from the Washington coast. The vessel was observing fish stocks off the entrance to the Strait of Juan de Fuca. The vessel is equipped for otter-trawl and gill-net fishing. It carries a hydrographic winch on the forward deck. The masts of the vessel hold radar and meteorological equipment.
