Over the years, there have been dramatic changes in the sardine, mackerel, and anchovy resources of the California Current. The evaluation and management of those interrelated stocks has been greatly aided by the studies of the Fishery-Oceanographic Center at La Jolla, Calif. That research complex--including marine laboratories of Federal, State, and private agencies--has helped make southern California one of the leading fishery research areas in the United States.
