

# FISH AND SHELLFISH OF THE MIDDLE ATLANTIC STATES

A 32-page handbook of information on the fish and shellfish of the Middle Atlantic area from Cape Hatteras to the eastern tip of Long Island, compiled by Rachel L. Carson, biologist, has just been issued by the Fish and Wildlife Service as Conservation Bulletin No. 38



The new bulletin discusses the fishery resources, economics, fishing gear, fishing grounds and conservation in this particular area, and gives, in addition, information on 22 species of fish and shellfish native to these waters.
